RED HOOK CLEAN-UP

Crews dispatched from Coffey Park this morning at 8:30 am to continue clean-up efforts in the Red Hook Houses. Portable boiler systems are in place to provide emergency heat to residents.

SBA DISASTER ASSITANCE

Will be in Red Hook speaking to neighbors about low interest loans up to \$50,000. Loans are being made available to homeowners, renters and businesses to repair damaged property and replace items lost in the hurricane and flooding.

This afternoon Mayor Bloomberg announced NYC Rapid Repairs, an unprecedented partnership with FEMA to quickly and efficiently fix homes damaged by Sandy. Not only will homeowners who enroll in the program get back in their homes faster, they will not have to pay upfront for the repairs. Beginning Tuesday 11/13, homeowners will be able sign up for NYC Rapid Repairs by going to NYC.gov or by calling 311. They will need a FEMA ID number, which they can get by registering at DisasterAssistance.gov or by calling 1-800-621-3362.
