NYCHA UTILITIES UPDATE

All NYCHA buildings now on the grid, save two. Electricians are still inspecting stairwells, compactors, courtyard, and elevators. Boilers going up to supply heat to all buildings and should be ready today.

ELECTRICITY RESTORATION PROCESS

Con Ed and the Dept. of Buildings have a turn-on request/certification process for service restoration: 1) Get your energy equipment inspected, cleaned, and repaired by a licensed contractor. 2) Have contractor complete a Self Certification Form. 3) Submit forms to www.coned.com, or in person (recommended) at the Customer Outreach van located at **Richards St. and Wolcott St.** Schedule inspections by phone: (718) 802-6349.
