Schools

- Citywide closure as of **March 17th through April 20th**. Students, teachers, and principals do not report.
- Grab-and-Go breakfast and lunch will be available at the entrance of every building from 7:30 am-1:30 pm. Any student can pick up breakfast and lunch at any school building tomorrow and until further notice.
- **Starting Tuesday March 17th--Thursday March 19th,** teachers and administrators will participate in professional development on remote learning.
- Students will begin picking up materials for continued instruction, including the technology necessary for remote learning for students who need it. More guidance to families will be sent this week
- Starting Monday March 23, remote learning will launch for grades K-12. DOE will support schools at all levels of readiness to deliver remote learning, and more information will be provided to families about online platforms.
- Regional Enrichment Centers will be available for the children of first responders, healthcare workers, transit workers, and our most vulnerable student populations, with more details to follow.
- Learn at Home--Get DOE-specific Learn at Home instructional resources in English for students in grades Pre-K through 12, including for diverse learning and students with disabilities (coming Monday, March 16, 2020).

<u>Housing</u>

Red Hook Justice Center will be closed as of today, Monday March 16th. Staff will be working remotely and are available. Also note: If new repairs:

- 1. please open a NYCHA ticket by calling 718-707-7771 and MyNYCHA app
- 2. if unaddressed, please contact Ross Joy at 347-216-5738 or email joyr@nycourts.gov who will contact NYCHA management

3. if emergency repairs still go unaddressed, tenant can file an HP Action with Justice Center clerks relocated at 120 Schermerhorn Street (court room TBA). Moratorium on evictions--except for emergency repair cases

Criminal court is administratively adjourned for at least 90 days

Housing court is also administratively adjourned, and **halted to all eviction proceedings.**

Open repair cases will be addressed by phone and email. For more info (Rent hardship, repairs, and administrative hearings go here).

Effective Tuesday March 17th, all bars and restaurants will be closed. Restaurants could continue delivery services. Starting 8pm tonight, all movie theaters, small theaters, nightclubs, and commercial gyms will be closed.

 - o Adjournment via request can be made by calling hearing office (718.218.1182)
 - Have the hearing notice in hand and call the number on that notice
 - Any senior who can't attend a hearing their case will be adjourned for up to 60 days with no fault your a senior

- NYCHA has a moratorium on evictions effectively immediately
- NYC enacts moratorium on ALL housing evictions effective Monday March 16th
